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## ADMISSION PROCEDURE CHECKLIST

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Below are the required procedures for applying to Canterbury School.

**Application:** The application for admission must be completed and returned to the Office of Admission with an application fee of \$65.00 (\$125.00 for international students). Applications completed by January 31 will be reviewed by March 10. After January 31, the applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis as spaces are available.

**Personal Interview:** A personal interview is required of all applicants. Interviews are scheduled Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday 8:30 am-2:00 pm, Wednesdays and Saturdays 8:30 am-13:00"cm. On-campus interviews can be scheduled by calling the Office of Admission at (860) 210-3832. If an applicant cannot come to campus to interview, an interview with a Canterbury School representative may be arranged.

*What is a Canterbury Interview?*

*The interview is the next step in the admission process after you have completed an inquiry.*

*It is a chance to meet and talk with our students and faculty in the course of a normal school day. You will have an individualized tour with one of our students and then talk with a member of our Admission team in a relaxed setting. Call us to schedule an appointment. We look forward to seeing you.*

**Recommendations:** Two TEACHER recommendations (English and Math), one GUIDANCE COUNSELOR recommendation, and a PARENT statement are required for each applicant.

**A Graded Essay:** Applicants must include an essay of their choice which has been submitted to and graded by a current teacher.

**Transcript:** Applicants must have their school forward their official transcript to the Office of Admission. We recommend that the transcript be sent in January and reflect first semester grades.

**Testing:** Applicants for the Third, Fourth, and Fifth Forms must take the Secondary School Admission Test (SSAT). Fifth Formers have the option of taking the PSAT or SSAT. When registering for the test, applicants should enter the Canterbury School code number, 2050, to ensure that test results are forwarded directly to the Office of Admission.

Applicants for a post-graduate (PG) year must forward their Scholastic Aptitude Test scores (SATs).

Applicants for whom English is a second language should take the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) in addition to the SSAT or SAT.
